The T20 league got the 2<sup>nd</sup> round underway on a very wet 1 May last weekend. After numerous attempts to dry the pitch, FCC finally won the toss and decided to bowl.

ACC, put it to bat, didn't have the quickest start with the first 3 batsmen all averaging under a run a ball. K. Razaq (37) played a largely supportive role once the 3<sup>rd</sup> wicket fell and N. Butt came to the crease. N. Butt scored his unbeaten 57 runs off only 26 deliveries, which put ACC in a good position as the innings started drawing to a close.
