Bangladesh playing Gaspar Correia in the first game of the evening, won the toss and batted first. Bangladesh put on 118 runs all out, with Ahad (21), Nahid (22*) and Tanveer (15) making double figures. In reply Gaspar Correia never really managed the required run rate, managing 82 runs all out in the eight over, losing by 36 runs, with no batsman making double figures.

Kings of Punjab played Oeiras in the second game. Oeiras, lost the toss and batted first. Oeiras lost P. Buccimazza in the first over, but stabilised with R. Shurma (37*) and H. Shahzad (22*) playing positively, and ending on 109 runs for the loss of 4 wickets. In response, Kings of Punjab never matched the required run rate and were dismissed for 82 runs in the ninth over, losing by 27 runs, with Pinder (20) being the main contributor.
